

**MORAVIA CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 15, 2019**

The special meeting of the Moravia City Council was called to order by Mayor Irene Brooks at 4:38 PM on Tuesday, January 15, 2019, at Moravia City Hall. In addition to Mayor Brooks, those present were Councilpersons Ken Martin, John Baty, Ruth Sheldon, Don Havard, and Shawn Richardson. Sharla Stogdill, Jason Snow, and Sheila Kirby were also present. The meeting opened with a prayer by Ken Martin and the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Brooks welcomed the public.

Motion by Havard and seconded by Martin to approve the agenda. Roll Call Vote: Martin-Aye, Baty-Aye, Sheldon-Aye, Havard-Aye, Richardson-Aye. Motion carried.

Comments from the public – None.

Councilpersons Martin and Baty met on Monday, January 14, 2019 and reviewed applications for the Maintenance Assistant job opening. The top two candidates will be interviewed on Monday, January 21.

City Clerk Sharla Stogdill reviewed the FY 2019/20 budget with the council. Additions and revisions to the budget were made and will be reviewed again at the next special meeting on Thursday, January 24 at 4:30 PM.

Council discussion items – Councilman Martin set up a meeting on Saturday, January 26 with Tim Kettle and Mike Robinson about the cemetery expansion. A cell tower is being erected on Ken Martin's property south of his house and he needs a 911 address for it. Councilman Baty discussed the city's snow ordinances. An ordinance posting will be placed in businesses in town. The snow ordinances will also be added to the agenda for the next special meeting on January 24. Councilman Richardson discussed the big water leak that was just found and how the new pits will help give early warning indicators if there is a leak.
