

**MORAVIA CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING  
MONDAY, JUNE 14, 2021**

A special meeting of the Moravia City Council was called to order by Mayor Roy Miller at 4:08 PM on Monday, June 14, 2021, at Moravia City Hall. In addition to Mayor Miller, those present were Councilpersons Sheila Kirby, John Baty, Ron Deal, and Gary Ehrle. Councilman Ken Martin was absent. Sharla Stogdill and Marcia Benjamin were also present. The meeting opened with a prayer by Gary Ehrle and the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Miller welcomed the public.

Motion by Baty and seconded by Deal to approve the agenda. Roll Call Vote: Kirby-Aye, Ehrle-Aye, Baty-Aye, Deal-Aye, Martin-Absent. Motion carried.

Comments from the public – None.

The City Council reviewed and discussed the allocation of LOSST funds. The current fiscal year LOSST deposits were much higher than average due to an increase in spending after the pandemic hit the economy a year ago. The average LOSST deposits for the previous five years was considerably lower. Councilman Ehrle said a specific dollar amount could be allocated to the Appanoose County Law Center instead of a percentage. Motion by Kirby and seconded by Baty to rescind Resolution #11-2021 dated June 8, 2021. Roll Call Vote: Ehrle-Aye, Deal-Aye, Baty-Aye, Kirby-Aye, Martin-Absent. Resolution rescinded. Motion by Baty and seconded by Deal to approve Resolution #16-2021 to allocate the LOSST funds to the Moravia General Funds Fire Department Fund 50% per year, the Appanoose County Law Center \$5,000 per year, and the Moravia Special Revenues Road Use Tax Fund 50% less \$5,000 per year. Roll Call Vote: Ehrle-Aye, Deal-Aye, Baty-Aye, Kirby-Aye, Martin-Absent. Resolution passed and approved.

Motion by Deal and seconded by Kirby to approve the cigarette/tobacco permit application for Dollar General. Roll Call Vote: Ehrle-Aye, Deal-Aye, Baty-Aye, Kirby-Aye, Martin-Absent. Motion carried.

Council Discussion Items – Councilman Deal attended the housing summit meeting on June 11 sponsored by Chariton Valley Planning and Development. Bill Cortesio spoke at the meeting about the Ultra 7 Development Plan. Councilman Deal will inquire if Cortesio can attend the council meeting in July to give more information about a housing development in Moravia. Councilman Baty discussed a water leak on Trussell. Council wants to proceed with getting bids for two road projects. Councilman Ehrle inquired about rules for mowing and distinguishing between yards and pastures.

Mayor Info and Discussion Items – Mayor Miller notified the council of his vacation dates. An email regarding the American Rescue Act information and funds was sent to the council to review.

Motion by Deal and seconded by Baty to adjourn at 4:33 PM. All Ayes. Motion carried.
